

ORDINANCE NO. 485

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING WILSONVILLE CODE SECTIONS 5.082(2) AND 5.084, RELATING TO PROHIBITED PARKING.

WHEREAS, the city of Wilsonville wishes to keep its regulations regarding prohibited parking current;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS (old language stricken, new language underlined):

1. Section 5.082(2) of the Wilsonville Code, **Parking Regulations - Prohibited Parking or Standing**, is amended to read as follows: "A motor truck with a gross vehicle weight of more than 8,000 pounds, and trailers, travel trailers and mobile coaches as defined by section 4.001 of the code on a street between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. of the following day in front of or adjacent to a residence, motel, apartment house, hotel or other sleeping accommodation, unless otherwise specifically adopted by action of the City Council;" and

2. Section 5.084 of the Wilsonville Code, **Parking Regulations - Prohibited Parking**, is amended to read as follows: "No operator shall park and no owner shall allow a vehicle to be parked upon a street, **public right of way, or public property** for the principal purpose of:

(1) Displaying the vehicle for sale.


(2) Repairing or servicing the vehicle, except repairs necessitated by an emergency.

(3) Displaying advertising from the vehicle. **Incidental parking of a vehicle with such advertising that is permanently or semi-permanently attached to the vehicle and would normally be construed as routine self-promotion, including the name, address, logo, slogan or product description of the vehicle owner is not intended to be prohibited.**

(4) Selling merchandise from the vehicle, except when authorized."


SUBMITTED to the Wilsonville City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on the 4th day of August, 1997, and scheduled for a second reading at a

regular Council meeting on the 18th day of August, 1997, commencing at the hour of 7 p.m., at the Wilsonville Community Development Hearings Room.


