

RESOLUTION NO. 1623

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE TO SUPPORT WEST LINN-WILSONVILLE SCHOOL DISTRICT LOCAL OPTION LEVY.

WHEREAS, over 4,500 k-12 students in West Linn and 2,600 students in Wilsonville attend the West Linn-Wilsonville School District; and

WHEREAS, each year over 2,000 adult residents use the West Linn-Wilsonville facilities for Community Education classes to extend their lifelong learning; and

WHEREAS, over 3,000 students participate in youth recreation programs in or on West Linn and Wilsonville facilities; and

WHEREAS, West Linn-Wilsonville School District and the cities of West Linn and Wilsonville are partners in a number of programs including community education, youth recreation, and a pioneering intergovernmental agreement; and

WHEREAS, the value of a quality education system is essential to the quality of life in our communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The City Council supports and endorses the local option levy for the West Linn-Wilsonville School District to be presented to the voters in May 2000.
