RESOLUTION NO. 2201

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE APPROVING THE BID PROCESS; ACCEPTING THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BID; AWARDING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT TO ROBERT GRAY PARTNERS, INC., THE LOWEST RESPONSIBLE BIDDER; AND VERIFYING FUND AVAILABILITY FOR THE PROJECT COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS COMMUTER RAIL RESTROOMS/DRIVER BREAKROOM.

WHEREAS, the Commuter Rail Restroom/Driver Break Room Project was duly advertised for pre-qualification and competitive bids in the Daily Journal of Commerce, a newspaper of general circulation as well as The Skanner, the Asian Reporter, and El Hispanic News; and

WHEREAS, three sealed bids were received prior to 12 p.m. local time, August 10, 2009, at the City Hall, 29799 SW Town Center Loop East, Wilsonville, OR, 97070; and

WHEREAS, the three bids were then opened individually, and separately read aloud at 1 p.m., local time, August 11, 2009. The Summary of Bids is marked Exhibit "A", attached hereto and incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, Robert Gray Partners, Inc. submitted the lowest responsible bid in the amount of \$361,888.00; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to execute a Construction Contract Agreement in the amount of \$361,888.00 in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the City's FY09-10 budget includes a \$650,000 appropriation for the Commuter Rail Restroom/Driver Break Room Project; and

WHEREAS, the Commuter Rail Restroom/Driver Break Room Project has been awarded ARRA Stimulus Funds which will reimburse the City's budgeted expenses on this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Subject to the final review and approval of the City Engineer and in accordance with the provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes, Chapter 279, Public Bids and Contracting; Wilsonville Code 2.3.14, Contracts with the City; and the Attorney General's Model Rules which the City has adopted as its contracting rules; the City Council acting as the Contract Review Board hereby awards the contract for construction to Robert Gray Partners, Inc.

- 2. Subject to final completion of all improvements specified in the contract documents and any supplementary changes, the City Engineer is authorized to certify the required improvements complete and make final payment including release of retainage.
- 3. The City Engineer is authorized to approve change orders to this contract as required provided, however, that the total cost does not exceed the approved budget for this project.
- 4. The City Council hereby authorizes the expenditures for this contract not to exceed the total FY09-10 budget amount:

5. This resolution becomes effective upon adoption.
