SUBJECT: Request to Sell Radio Equipment

The City of Wilsonville presently has two prospective buyers for the present low frequency radio system for the City. The City of Wilsonville approved during the supplemental budget the allocation to purchase the new high frequency radio system with a direct tie-in to the Tualatin Rural Fire Protection District. The Tie with T.R.F.P.D. will provide direct monitoring of our public utilities 24 hours per day.

Since the budget has been watched carefully for expenditures the purchase of the present low frequency system by an outside party would provide possibly 2/3 of the amount necessary to purchase the new high frequency system.

## Recommendation

Approve establishing the present low frequency radio system as surplus equipment and advertise for bids.
