SUBJECT: Purchase Bark Dust - Charbonneau Reservoir

The landscaping at the Charbonneau Reservoir has been in now for about $2\frac{1}{2}$ years and the area around the Pumping Station is in need of rebarking. Primarily due to the steep grades, and the area of placement the bark dust will have to be blown in rather than placed.

The total number of units to complete the bark dusting is approximately 8, and can be done for \$116.00/unit or a total cost of \$928.00. Funds are available in Water Fund 03-55 330 Repair/Maintenance Supplies.

Recommendation

Approve the purchase of 8 units of bark dust to be blown in and supplied by McFarlanes at a price of \$116.00/unit or a total cost of \$928.00.
