SUBJECT: Accept Bid for New Radio System

During the Supplemental Budget the City Council - Budget Committee approved the funding to purchase a new radio/communication system. The new system would be a Motorola Maxar 30 V.H.F. system which is compatible to the V.H.F. systems with the Tualatin Rural Fire Protection District style of radio. The City will provide a direct intercom and emergency call unit at the District.

The radios will be purchased under the State Bid Price Contract that Motorala has with the State of Oregon which local entities can take advantage of. By approving the purchase of the radios under the 81/82 agreement prior to July 1, 1982, the City would not have to pay any price increases for the radio system.

Recommendation

- 1. Purchase the 7 Motorola Maxar 80 Mobile Units for a purchase price of \$620.00 each and a total cost of \$4,320,00.
- 2. Purchase the Motorola Super Consolette Base Station 60 watt for a total cost of \$3,030.00.
- 3. Purchase the 2.8 db gain antenna for \$252.00.
- 4. Purchase 140' of 1/2" low loss antenna line \$309.00.
- 5. Funds were appropriated in supplemental budget as follows:
