RESOLUTION 251

Resolution canvassing the vote of the May 18, 1982 election for the position of Mayor and for Councilman in Position No. 3 and Position No. 4.

WHEREAS at the primary election held May 18, 1982, the electorate of the City of Wilsonville cast ballots for the position of Mayor, and

WHEREAS, at the same election the electorate of the City of Wilsonville also cast ballots for Council Position 3 and for Council Position 4, and

WHEREAS, the County Clerk of Clackamas County who, by statute, is in charge of conducting all elections, has filed an abstract of the tally of votes cast at the election, which tally was received on June 6, 1982, and

WHEREAS, William G. Lowrie ran unopposed for the position of Mayor and received a total of 933 votes from a total of 1,092 votes cast. There were two write-in candidates for the position of Mayor. Bill Bates received one vote and John Ludlow received two votes, and

WHEREAS, James R. Farrell and William E. Stark ran for Council Position No. 3. James R. Farrell received a total of 353 votes and William E. Stark received a total of 566 votes from a total of 1,092 votes cast, and

WHEREAS, Robert W. (Bob) Harris and David G. Shafer ran for Council Position No. 4. Robert W. (Bob) Harris received a total of 861 votes and David G. Shafer received a total of 142 votes from a total of 1,092 votes cast, and

WHEREAS, the City Charter of the City of Wilsonville prescribes that the City Council shall canvas the vote for all city offices and measures, and the results of such canvas shall be entered into the record of proceedings of the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the City of Wilsonville through the City Council canvas the vote of the May 18, 1982, Primary Election and finds that:

- 1. William G. Lowrie received the highest number of votes cast, and the majority of votes cast for the position of Mayor, and
- 2. William E. Stark received the highest number of votes cast and the majority of votes cast for the position of Councilman, Position No. 3, and
- 3. Robert W. (Bob) Harris received the highest number of votes cast, and the majority of votes cast for the position of Councilman, Position No. 4.

4. In accordance with the Charter of the City of Wilsonville the following names shall be certified to the County Clerk as the single candidates for the positions shown for the November 2, 1982, General Election:

William G. Lowrie - Mayor William E. Stark - Council Position No. 3 Robert W. (Bob) Harris - Council Position No. 4

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Recorder of the City of Wilsonville is hereby instructed to certify the above names to the County Clerk of Clackamas County as the single candidates for the positions shown, and is further instructed to take appropriate and timely action to ensure that the single candidates for the positions shown appear on the November 2, 1982 General Election Ballot.
