SUBJECT: Contract Planning - Ryan O'Brien

Council approved the retention of Mr. O'Brien as a contract planner at the meeting of March 7, 1983.

At this meeting I erroneously informed you that no transfer of funds would be necessary. A further review, after the fact, indicates I was in error.

Mr. O'Brien receives his contractural compensation from the Planning Budget, Contractural Services, under the line item Planning Services, currently budgeted at \$8500.

I now find that you need to authorize a transfer from the Planning Budget, Materials and Services, line item Publication, Comprehensive Plan, currently budgeted at \$6,000. With the transfer this budget line item will be reduced to \$3,000.

I recommend that Council authorize the transfer of Recommendation: \$3,000 from fundsbudgeted in the Planning Department Materials and Services, Publications, Comprehensive Plan, to Contractural Services, Planning Services.
