## RESOLUTION NO. 383

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A CITY TAX BASE ELECTION IN THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, CLACKAMAS AND WASHINGTON COUNTIES, OREGON, ON MAY 15, 1984, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE, OREGON, THE QUESTION ESTABLISHING AN INCREASED TAX BASE TO PROVIDE REVENUE FOR THE OPERATION OF WILSONVILLE CENTER AKA SENIOR CENTER, AND APPLYING THE LIMITATION ON TAXATION SET FORTH IN ARTICLE XI, SECTION 11, OREGON CONSTITUTION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Wilsonville, Oregon, has determined that an increased tax base should be established as authorized by Article XI, Section 11, Subsection (2), Oregon Constitution, in order to permit the proper operation of the city affairs and operation of the new Wilsonville Center aka Wilsonville Senior Center within the limitation contained in Article XI, Oregon Constitution, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to submit the question of establishing an increased tax base to the legal voters of the City of Wilsonville, Oregon;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Common Council of the City of Wilsonville , resolves as follows:

- 1. The measure set forth in Section 3 shall be submitted in the manner prescribed herein to the legal voters of the City of Wilsonville, Oregon, at a city tax base election to be held on May 15, 1984.
- 2. The tax base measure shall repeal the current 3-year serial levy as proposed by the Common Council of the City of Wilsonville adoption of Resolution No. 315, and approved by the legal voters of the City of Wilsonville, Oregon, May 23, 1983.

3. At the city tax base election there shall be as submitted to the legal voters of the City of Wilsonville, for their approval or rejection, the following measure:

CAPTION:

"TO ESTABLISH A NEW TAX BASE"

## QUESTION:

"Shall the City of Wilsonville be authorized to increase its tax base from \$318,000 to \$367,080 for fiscal year 1984-1985?"

## **EXPLANATION:**

"The City of Wilsonville has a 1983-84 tax base of \$318,000.00. It is proposed this base be increased by \$49,080.00 effective in 1984-85. The purpose of this increase is to fund the Wilsonville Center (Senior Center) and allow the city the constitutionally authorized 6% increase on the existing tax base. City services include water, sewer, lighting, police, parks, street and bridge construction and maintenance, administration and senior center operations, with an overall budget of \$8,192,735.00. Continued city services requires tax revenues. The taxation limit in Article XI, Section 11, Oregon Constitution, allows no more than a six per cent increase in future years without voter approval. The proposed tax base of \$367,080. will be partially financed by the State of Oregon under present tax relief programs.

"Repeals Serial Levy for partial Senior Citizens Center funding of \$30,000.00 per year approved at May 23, 1983, election."

4. The City Recorder shall file this measure with the Election
Officers of Clackamas and Washington Counties as prescribed by law.
