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Vendor #1, misinterpreted the bid specifications and included a Tractor in their bid price.

Vendor #3, bid was not signed and did not meet all specifications the City called for. Also, delivery would be 30 to 60 days.

Vendor #2, bid states that their unit will meet or beat all specs[.] listed for bid call. Also find delivery time is immediate (per memo from Public Works Superintendent).

In summary, Vendor #2 is the only Vendor who's bid meets all specifications and requirements of the Cities request for bid. Recommendation:

SUBJECT: BID PROPOSALS FOR FLAIL MOWER

I have reviewed the bid proposals for the side mounted mower that we received 4/30/85 and list the following comments for your consideration.

Item #1: The bid from General Equipment Company totaling \$8,328.00 has not been signed by anyone from their company. I would question the legality of the bid without a signature.

Item #2: General Equipment has no supporting engineering data to verify that their equipment can comply with our bid specifications. I went over to their office and found that they had no equipment on hand to compare with. They said that it would be from 30 to 60 days before the proposed equipment could be delivered. They also said that the proposed equipment that they have would need to be altered to meet our specifications.

Item #3: In Specification Number K General Equipment Company said that their equipment could only meet the specifications at the ground position and at the top position that their boom moves in an arc. We are in need of a cutter that can move in a vertical cut to trim the rose bushes along Boones Ferry and the Freeway.

Item #4: Yeager Ford Tractor has all the supporting engineering data. They have said that the equipment we need is on hand and could be fitted to our tractor within a week.

Recommendation: I would recommend we accept Yeager Ford Tractor's bid proposal for \$8,890.00
