WHEREAS, the city staff has prepared a report on the above captioned subject which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has duly considered the subject and the recommendation(s) contained in the staff report; and



EXHIBIT "A"

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE USE POLICY

WILSONVILLE COMMUNITY CENTER

The following policy regarding the use of alcoholic beverages is hereby adopted by the Wilsonville City Council:

1. Alcoholic beverages, limited to beer and wine, may be allowed in the Wilsonville Community Center upon approval of a completed application by the City Administrator or his authorized representative.
2. The City Administrator shall develop and update as necessary, an Alcoholic Beverage Application Form for the Wilsonville Community Center.
3. Applicants shall assume, by accepting the terms of the application, all liability resulting from the service of alcoholic beverages in the Wilsonville Community Center. The applicant shall agree to hold the City of Wilsonville harmless from all claims resulting from the service of alcoholic beverages in the Wilsonville Community Center.
4. Applicants shall assume, by accepting the terms of the application, all responsibility for complying with all Oregon laws and Oregon Liquor Control Commission Regulations regarding the sale, service and control of alcoholic beverages served in the Wilsonville Community Center.
