GROUND EQUIPMENT.**


WHEREAS, the city staff has prepared a report on the above captioned subject which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

SUBJECT: PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT  
BOONES FERRY PARK

The Parks and Recreation Department received four proposals for playground equipment scheduled for installation in Boones Ferry Park.

A wide range of playground equipment was proposed by the respondents, with two of the manufactures listing more than one option for equipment.

The City has a maximum of \$4,000.00 for the purchase of this equipment. The range of proposals is as follows:

Based on a review of the proposals staff recommends acceptance of the proposal from Wildwood Playgrounds in the amount of \$4,000.00. The basis for recommendation of Wildwood Playgrounds system is the following:

1. Provides a warranty equal to or better than any other manufacture.
2. Provides proposal within existing funding.
3. Provides eighteen different motion activities with a greater diversity and age range when compared to the minimum requirements and other manufactures proposals.

4. The benefit to the community and the park system from these added systems far outweighs the slight increase in cost above other proposals being considered.
5. The Wildwood Playground System is modular in nature and easily adapts to a most advantageous arrangement for the Boones Ferry Park setting.
