All assessment payments have been received for LID #6 and the refinancing warrants are due November 30, 1988 in the amount of \$1,063,300.00.

The City currently has funds on hand from the assessment payments and interest earned in the approximate amount of \$1,022,544.00. In order to clear this LID up and make the final payments due, the City will have to pay the difference between cash on hand and warrants due in the amount of \$40,756.00.

The logical fund to pay this shortfall is the System Development Fund. There is budget and funds available for this expense.

RECOMMENDATION:

Approve payment of approximately \$40,756.00 from the City's System Development fund to accompany the approximate amount of \$1,022,544.00 to pay LID #6 warrants in full due on November 30, 1988.
