Following the Nov. 7, 1988 Council meeting the formal bid process was initiated for the purchase of the sludge truck tank. request for bid was advertised in the correct time-frame and four specific packets were requested and sent out. After following all the correct procedures to receive competitive bids, we did run into one problem - we didn't receive any bids.

Since the existing tank is in such poor condition, we felt it was imperative that some solution be presented to you at the Dec. 5th We contacted the State Purchasing Division and they meeting. suggested the following solutions:

- have the governing body declare an emergency and then a. we could arbitrarily contract any qualified vendor to perform the work. (This would not eliminate the possibility of a challenge by a vendor that was not chosen to perform the work)
- b. extend the time that bids will be received and see if we would receive some response.

It was determined after contacting the vendors who had received specification packets, that our specs were in order and that the reason we had not received any bids was due to the fact that the vendors just had been to busy to complete the bids. Three of the four vendors were still interested in preparing a bid.

We decided to extend the acceptance time until Monday, Dec. 5 at We will open the bids, compile the data and present 10:00am. this information to you at the Council meeting for your action. We have attached a copy of the original request for bid and the specifications for your information. REQUEST FOR BID

The City of Wilsonville, Oregon will be accepting bids for an aluminum 4,000 gallon replacement tank for the City's sludge truck.

Bids will be received by Ray Shorten, Finance Director until 11:00am on Tuesday, November 29, 1988 at which time the bids will be publicly opened in the Council chambers of City Hall. Specifications for the new tank can be picked up at City Hall located at 30000 S.W. Town Center Loop East, Wilsonville Oregon or specifications can be mailed to any interested bidder by calling at 682-1011.

Bids must be sealed and clearly marked "BID ON SLUDGE TRUCK TANK".

Wilsonville City Council may award the bid at their regularly scheduled meeting December 5, 1988 or reserves the right to reject any or all bids that appear to be not in the public's best interest.

SPECIFICATIONS SLUDGE TRUCK TANK

The City of Wilsonville is requesting a bid to remove and dispose of the existing tank on the City's sludge truck and replace it with a 4,000 gallon aluminum tank. The successful bidder will be expected to provide the new tank within 90 days the award of the bid. The City will provide the transportation of the truck to and from the vendor, who will be allowed 7 working days to remove the old tank and install the new tank. If vendor is outside a 50 mile radius of Wilsonville, mileage and travel time for City staff will be considered when reviewing the bid.

The following detailed specifications should be considered and included in the preparation of the sealed bid:

Tank Capacity:

4,000 gallons

Design:

oval pattern, bolster mounting with 10" slope, spring hold-down pads, top rails and ladder up front head driver side. All seams double welded and tested. Tank must be constructed to withstand frequent trips on rough terrain.

Material:

.25" aluminum 5454 H-32 alloy on the bottom and .188" on the remainder of the tank.

Baffles:

Minimum of (2) perpendicular baffles and additional perpendicular baffles as required for manufacturing. Baffles shall have a crawl-hole in each for access to each compartment.

Fill Hole:

16" full opening, hinged with quick locking cover which forms seal when closed. Install opening as close to the front of the tanks as possible.

Vent:

Manufactured 1-way vent valve sufficient to allow 400 gallons per minute to be pumped out of the tanks though a 4" line. A tee vent is not acceptable.

Outlet:

Install an 8" pipe at the low point in the rear of the tank for discharge.

Discharge valve:

Fittings:

Install full tandem aluminum fenders and

Tool Box:

Steel fitting box with lid furnished and installed on driver side. 42" wide x 22"

As stated in Resolution CB-R-364-88, Exhibit A in the Council Packet the bid acceptance time was extended until today, Monday December 5, 1988 at 10:00 am. The potential bidders were notified by phone to advise them of this change in the specifications.

At 10:00 am we had received one bid from Beal Trans-Liner. Although the bid was received on time, the bid was incomplete as it did not give a total sum for all the work to be performed. They showed an amount of \$15,238.00 plus would charge time and materials both to remove the old tank and to install the valve.

At 1:30 pm we received a bid from Metal Technologies. They stated that the extension time was unclear and they were not aware that our deadline was at 10:00am. Although their bid was late, their price was totally inclusive at \$15,886.00.

RECOMMENDATION:

Since both bids had imperfections and if time allowed we should throw out both bids and try once more. Since the existing tank is in such poor condition and more leaks are imminent, we are recommending that City Council declare an emergency and award the bid to Metal Technologies in the amount of \$15,886.00. Although their bid was late, the pricing was complete with a total sum given to perform all the work stated in the specification packet. The other bid was dependent on time and materials needed to remove the tank and mount the valve.
