RE: SHORT-TERM LOAN TO TRANSIT SYSTEM FUND

In order to cover the start-up and initial operating costs of the transit system, it will be necessary to obtain a short term loan from the General Fund. We estimate that funds from the 1st quarter billing should be received in late April or May, 1989. As soon as sufficient funds are received to cover this loan, including interest, it will be repaid.

## **RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve a short-term loan from the General Fund to the Transit System Fund in the amount of \$25,000.00. Interest to be accrued at the same rate as generated by the Local Government Pool during the period of time the loan is in effect.
