1989 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT I

City staff began advertising for bids on July 24 for pavement repair of approximately 35,000 square feet of surface area on city streets throughout Wilsonville. The emphasis of the 1989 Improvement Project I will be to repair the especially deteriorated road sections on Wilsonville Road, Boones Ferry Road and French Prairie Drive. The emphasis of the 1990 Improvement Project II will be to apply a seal coat to pavement surfaces throughout the City.

The scope of work for Project I is explained in exhibit no. 2. Based on the bids received recently for the Wilsonville Road repair and overlay at the railroad crossing, the staff estimate of cost for the repair of 35,000 square feet is \$138,250. Following pavement repairs by the contractor, city maintenance crews will begin crack sealing, especially on Town Center Loop West and French Prairie Drive. City maintenance crews will also perform pothole repair work on Rose Lane, Commerce Circle and portions of Parkway Avenue. City-wide pavement striping will begin in October after all pavement repairs are complete.

Attachment "A", to be included with the bid award resolution, will be distributed the evening of August 7.

#### Recommendation:

On August 7, accept the low qualified bid presented in attachment "A" and authorize the expenditure of \$150,000 for the 1989 Road Improvement Project I.

# CITY OF WILSONVILLE 1989 ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT I

Scope of Work:

Cut, excavate and patch areas of existing pavement failure involving approximately 35,000 square feet of pavement surface area.

Location of Work:

Three existing roadways within the city limits of Wilsonville: 1) Wilsonville Road, 3.1 miles; 2) Boones Ferry Road, 2.9 miles; 3) French Prairie Drive, 2.2 miles. Cut and removal area to be at the discretion of the Facility Maintenance Supervisor.

Materials:

Cuts to be performed with a saw or jackhammer. Excavate 12" of existing material. Excavated material to be replaced with a minimum of 9 inches of 3/4" minus rock compacted; tack edges and base surface with a minimum of 3 inches of Class "C" asphalt compacted to 90 percent or better.

Schedule of Work:

Contractor selected shall proceed with work within seven (7) days of award of contract, and shall complete work within 45 days of award of contract.
