

RESOLUTION NO. 761

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE BID PROCESS, ACCEPTING THE LOW QUALIFIED BID; AWARDING THE CONTRACT TO THE LOW QUALIFIED BIDDER; VERIFYING FUND AVAILABILITY; AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING STAFF TO APPROVE ALL PAYMENTS FOR WELL DEVELOPMENT AT MENTOR GRAPHICS, FOR THE PROJECT KNOWN AS MUNICIPAL WELL AND TEST PUMPING.**

WHEREAS, bids were received prior to 3:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time, Tuesday, February 20, 1990 at Wilsonville City Hall Annex, 8445 S.W. Elligsen Road, Wilsonville, Oregon 97070. Bids were then opened individually and separately read aloud after 3:00 p.m. Pacific Standard Time on February 20, 1990, and are listed in the attached Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Wilsonville City Engineering Department has reviewed all bids received for completeness, additions and omissions; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Director recommends the award of the contract for the Municipal Well and Test Pumping Project, for an amount not to exceed \$78,105.00; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has reviewed the fund to which expenditures will be accounted to, and has verified that funds are available to complete this project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wilsonville that:

1. The City Council acknowledges that all bids were received, publicly opened and approved as being completed for consideration for award according to the provisions of Oregon Revised Statutes 279.025, "Requirements of Advertisement".
2. The acceptance of the contract and awarding the contract to the lowest qualified bidder, as described in attachment "A".
3. Authorize the expenditure of funds for this contract from:
