A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE BID PROCESS; ACCEPTING THE LOW QUALIFIED BID; AWARDING THE CONTRACT TO THE LOW QUALIFIED BIDDER; VERIFYING FUND AVAILABIILTY; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE PROJECT KNOWN AS THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE WASTEWATER ODOR CONTROL IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, bids were received prior to 3:00 p.m. Pacific Daylight Time, Thursday, June 27, 1991, at the Community Development Department, 8445 SW Elligsen Road, Wilsonville, Oregon 97070. Bids were then opened individually and separately read aloud after 3:00 p.m. Pacific Daylight Time on June 27, 1991, and are listed in the attached Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the engineering firm of Curran McLeod, Inc., Consulting Engineers has reviewed all bids received for completeness, additions and omissions; and

WHEREAS, the Community Development Director recommends the award of the contract for the Odor Control Improvements Project, for an amount not to exceed \$371,967.50; and

WHEREAS, the Finance Director has reviewed the fund to which expenditures will be accounted to, and has verified that funds are available to complete this project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Wilsonville that:

ENGINEERS RECOMMENDATION OF AWARD

Dear Steve:

Bids were received and reviewed for the Odor Control Improvements Project at the Wilsonville Wastewater Treatment Plant. The proposals were reviewed for execution, bonding, dollar amounts, prequalification and compliance with the bid procedure.

A tabulation of all bid items is attached. Six bids were received as follows:

Copenhagen Utilities, Inc.	\$ 330,438.00
GTE Metal Erectors	364,052.00
Daneal Construction	366,537.00
Copenhagen, Inc.	379,372.00
Pneumatic Construction, Inc.	443,811.00
G.H. McCulloch, Inc.	469,800.00

Bid Execution

Each of the six bids was executed properly, with bidder's signature, title, secretary's signature, identification of Oregon incorporation status and acknowledgment of Addenda 1 and 2. Only two of the bidders acknowledged being resident bidders; GTE Metal Erectors and Pneumatic Construction, Inc. Additionally, G.H. McCulloch, Inc. conditioned their bid on a completion time of 160 days as opposed to 120 specified.

Bid Bonding

The bid security appears acceptable for all bidders except G.H. McCulloch, Inc. who is in the process of re-qualifying for a bid bond and did not submit bid security. As a result, the G.H. McCulloch, Inc bid is non-responsive. The date of bid bond execution varied from the bid date of June 27, 1991, on three of the five responsive bids. The apparent low bidder, Copenhagen Utilities, dated the bid bond and power of attorney June 20, 1991, a week prior to the bid date.

Bid Amounts

No material errors were identified in the bid figures, extensions or totals.

Prequalification

All bidders were prequalified to bid on this project.

Bid Procedure Compliance

All bids were submitted in compliance with the Instructions to Bidders, at the proper time and place.

Summary and Recommendation

In summary, only one bid contained sufficient deviation from the published requirements to be considered non-responsive. The high bid from G.H. McCulloch, Inc. did not contain bid security and is therefore non-responsive.

The apparent low bid from Copenhagen Utilities, Inc. of \$330,438.00 is very close to the Engineer's estimate of \$323,450.00. This bid is responsive and the firm has proven experience to accomplish this project.

Curran-McLeod, Inc. recommends award of the Odor Control Improvements project to Copenhagen Utilities, Inc. of Clackamas, Oregon, in the amount of \$330,438.00.
