

RESOLUTION NO. 1062

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ALL NON-UNION STAFF TO BE GRANTED THE SAME PAID HOLIDAYS AS THOSE THAT UNION REPRESENTED EMPLOYEES ARE GIVEN AS OUTLINED IN THE COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH OREGON PUBLIC EMPLOYEES UNION LOCAL #926.

WHEREAS, the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Wilsonville and the Oregon Public Employees Union Local #926 lists paid holidays as follows:

New Year's Day - January 1st
Martin Luther King, Jr.'s Birthday - Third Monday in January
President's Day - Third Monday in February
Memorial Day - Last Monday in May
Independence Day - July 4th
Labor Day - First Monday in September
Veteran's Day - November 11th
Thanksgiving Day - Fourth Thursday in November
Day after Thanksgiving
Christmas Day - December 25th; and


WHEREAS, as stated in the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Wilsonville and the Oregon Public Employees Union Local #926, if a holiday falls on a Saturday, the preceeding Friday shall be given as a holiday and if a holiday falls on a Sunday, the following Monday shall be given as a holiday; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Council of the City of Wilsonville that all non-union staff be allowed to take the same paid holidays as union represented staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES all non-union staff are entitled to the same paid holidays as union represented staff as outlined in the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City of Wilsonville and the Oregon Public Employees Union Local #926.


