## **RESOLUTION NO. 1193**

## A RESOLUTION REVISING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1994/95.

WHEREAS, the City adopted a budget for fiscal year 1994/95 by Resolution No. 1115 and appropriated funds by Resolution No. 1116; and

WHEREAS, unanticipated expenditures are expected to exceed the original adopted appropriations in some of the City's funds and budgetary changes are necessary within certain funds to avoid over-expenditure of appropriation levels; and

WHEREAS, ORS 294.450 provides that a city may transfer appropriations within a fund if approved by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF WILSONVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The appropriation categories for the following funds are to be amended as set forth below.

- 2. Building Capital Projects Fund resources change due to amendments in financing of projects. Transfers In shall increase by \$27,000 and Miscellaneous Revenue (in lieu of state loan proceeds) shall decrease by \$27,000.
- 3. General Fund Transfers In resource category shall be increased by \$30,000 pursuant to the Transfers Out listed above. Offsetting this increase shall be an increase to the Fund's unappropriated ending fund balance.
